MAXIMUM ALLOWANCE FOR THIS GRANT IS \$100.00 PER FIELD TRIP.

Please carefully review the instructions and Eligibility.

Grant Eligibility

- Must have at least 20 children on field trip
- Will appear for all the listed trip dates
- Must submit this application before field trip
- Must submit invoice within 30 days after field trip

This application MUST be submitted to the Museum before or during the field trip. In addition, an invoice must be submitted within 30 days after the school's field trip to receive funding.

Grant proposals are accepted throughout the school year. Submit the application via email at contact@hamuseum.org or in person. Please list the date of each field trip and a list of all of the teachers for each trip. A letter of acceptance will be provided once approved. Upon approval, an invoice must be submitted from the district to the Museum *within 30 days after* the field trips have occurred. Grant reimbursements are provided only as special transportation funds are available.
